**TO ALL PROPONENTS:**

**The following is continuation of Addendum 6a. It contains an additional question posed at the October 14, 2009, Proponents' Meeting in Vancouver, British Columbia, and its corresponding answer.**

**32. At what point is fuel switching for greenhouses business as usual?**

This issue should be addressed through the project proponent's baselining exercise. Based on the principles of conservatism that underpin BC's emissions offset regulations, if it is both reasonable and conservative to assume that a project proponent would engage in fuel switching as both economic and contractual conditions allow – then that fuel switching should be reflected in the business as usual scenario. If there is evidence that a project proponent has engaged in that type of behaviour in the past, then it may be reasonable to assume that the behaviour would continue in the future.
